**POTATO PRINTING**

## INDOOR ACTIVITY

Making a stamp from a potato is a great way to introduce your children to stamping. First cut the potato in half and using a marker pen, sketch your design. Then cut around this shape, leaving the design, so it is raised on the surface of the potato – you might need to do this part, depending on your child's age. You can then dip your potato stamp into some poster paint and press onto the paper to create your artwork. Once finished, you can wash the potato and leave to dry so the stamp can be re-used another day.

## OUTDOOR ACTIVITY

Make the most of the trees and plants in your garden by turning them into art. Get your child to collect a number of different leaves and flowers in many colours, shapes and sizes. Then help them to cut out and discard the centre of a paper plate and, using glue, begin to stick the leaves onto the remaining plate ring. Once you've layered on as many leaves as possible add a bit of extra decoration by sticking a bow made from ribbon on to the bottom. Once it's dry, you can hang it on their bedroom door as a fun decoration.
